PRESENTATION OF FINDINGS.

Exercise 6 has a few stages. The first stage, completed in class finds each group assigned to a dedicated space on campus. Once each group member has completed that the groups next task is to complete the following:

- arrange a meeting of all group members to evaluate accumulated data
- review each group members questionnaire.
- decide the best presentation method to compile and organize the visual and written data.
- these presentations can incorporate digital methods or more traditional analog methods but they should be clear and easy to read. All data should be used in the presentations and each group should utilize the individual strengths of the members.

Two possible presentation methods:

- a multimedia presentation incorporating visual and audio information, live reading and or video. (Powerpoint, Keynote, etc.)
- a live presentation that incorporates any of the above but could also include charts, graphs, plan drawings, or scale models. (EX: Research architectural models)
